Art Submission Requirements

Who may apply:

Lawyers, Therapists, Mediators, Musicians and Artists may submit original art related to the theme of Peace and Justice, including poverty, homelessness and political conflict. This art exhibit will be juried by Michael Solomon.

Submissions and Registration:

- Submit your entries for your original painting, sculpture, photography or multimedia work to: mike@nomolos.com
- You may submit up to three (3) entries per artist. We are only accepting digital submissions.
- Deadline for submission is **APRIL 6, 2010**
- If you are selected, a \$25 registration fee is required by May 22, 2010. *Finalists will be notified by MAY 1, 2010.*
- Selected artists are required to drop off and pick up any unsold works.

Criteria:

- Original art only (paintings, sculpture, photography, multimedia, etc...)
- Limited edition prints will be accepted.
- Appropriately framed for showing
- Fixed for hanging with all appropriate hardware attached. Artist must provide all installation materials if necessary.
- Each submission must be accompanied by an entry form (attached). You can also obtain an entry form by contacting CLA at 442-6210 x102.

Sales:

Art works may be offered for sale at a price determined by the artist.
